Favorite Song:



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6TH GRADE RETURNS TO UPPER ELEMENTARY

On March 22, the AMCS Board approved the restoration of 6th grade to upper elementary. Following this board approval, we held a town hall meeting with our current 4th and 5th grade families to discuss this matter. AMCS provided our 5th grade families the option to stay in upper elementary or to move on to middle school next school year. Out of 21 families, we received 14 responses where 86% agreed to restore the 6th grade to upper elementary in SY 2024-2025. In order to implement this plan successfully, there will be three to four upper elementary classes next year. Students currently in 4th and 5th grade may be re-assigned to other classrooms next school year.

Maria Montessori's vision of the classroom is a three year multigame grouping. An authentic Montessori upper elementary includes 4th, 5th and 6th grades together. This is the same grouping as in the primary with the PK3-Kindergaten and the lower elementary with the 1st-3rd graders.

El 22 de marzo, la Junta de AMCS aprobó la restauración del sexto grado a la primaria superior. Luego de la aprobación de esta junta, celebramos una reunión pública con nuestras familias actuales de 4° y 5° grado para discutir este asunto. AMCS brindó a nuestras familias de quinto grado la opción de permanecer en la primaria superior o pasar a la escuela intermedia el próximo año escolar. De 21 familias, recibimos 14 respuestas donde el 86% estuvo de acuerdo en restaurar el sexto grado a la primaria superior en el año escolar 2024-2025. Para implementar este plan con éxito, el próximo año habrá de tres a cuatro grados superiores de primaria. Los estudiantes que actualmente cursan 4.º y 5.º grado podrán ser reasignados a otras aulas el próximo año escolar.

La visión de María Montessori del aula es una agrupación de juegos múltiples de tres años. Una auténtica escuela primaria superior Montessori incluye 4°, 5° y 6° grados juntos. Este es el mismo agrupamiento que en primaria con los de PK3-Kindergaten y en primaria inferior con los alumnos de 1° a 3°.

Please be sure to stay hydrated and expect warm weather. Be sure to bring water for your entire family, sunscreen, and a hat, as we head into summer Houston is heating up.

Be sure to wear appropriate shoes for running and moving. No sandals, flip flops, Crocs, or open toed shoes.

Don't forget to bring a chair or blanket so you and your family can have a spot to rest!

Warning: there are no restroom facilities at the track. Please be sure to use the restroom before arriving. There is an Exxon gas station located 1 mile away on Alief Clodine Rd.
